General Electric also manufactures ovens with a steam clean feature. The steam clean feature works best for smaller spills but lacks the power for removing larger, tougher messes. However, because the internal temperature stays lower than during the self-cleaning cycle, the oven does not lock, and the cycle completes in about 30 minutes.

How Long Does It Take to Clean a GE Self-Cleaning Oven?

Occasionally, your self-cleaning GE oven won't unlock on its own after the cycle is over. Luckily, there are several ways to unlock your oven. Try resetting the oven's computer by switching the circuit breaker that controls the oven to "off" for 5 minutes. If the oven doesn't unlock, press the self-cleaning button again to restart the ...

A self-cleaning oven is a feature on many modern ovens that burns off cooking spills and splatters with an extremely high temperature (932 F° or 500 C°) to aid in cleaning. A cycle typically takes several hours to complete; and for safety measures, automatically locks the oven door closed until it has sufficiently cooled.
