The Passive Voice - Perfect English Grammar

The passive voice is used to show interest in the person or object that experiences an action rather than the person or object that performs the action. In other words, the most important thing or person becomes the subject of the sentence.

The passive of an active tense is formed by putting the verb to beinto the same tense as the active verb and adding the past participle of the active verb. The subject of the active verb becomes the 'agent' of the passive verb. The agent is very often not mentioned.

If it's a long sentence and you know who the subject is, it's best to use the active voice. The passive is often used to report something or to state a fact. Highway 15 was closed yesterday due to a serious road accident.
